### **Policy for Off Campus Recruiting**

Commandant's Policy: Cadets may participate in College Nights if the plan to do so is safe. For trips out-side of 100 miles from campus a Commandant's Staff member will be required to drive unless the cadet(s) is/are remaining overnight at the location. In any case the cadet(s) should not be driving on the road late at night.

University/rental vehicles will only be provided if a staff member is driving.

Academic success is the highest priority and we cannot undermine this with the university and faculty. Unless the event is of great importance to the Corps or the University, class excuse letters will not be issued or requested. College nights and recruiting events do not generally fall into this category.

The Office of the Commandant and Corps Staff has a responsibility and liability for all activities of the Corps. You are not allowed to represent the Corps without approval through your chain of command by the Corps Recruiting Officer and the appropriate Commandant's Staff member (if applicable). In accordance with university regulations cadets will complete a pre-event planning form, university waiver form, and submit a Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT) travel form within 48 hours of departure (all forms are available on-line) for any event more than 25 miles from campus. Review the University Travel Rules.
